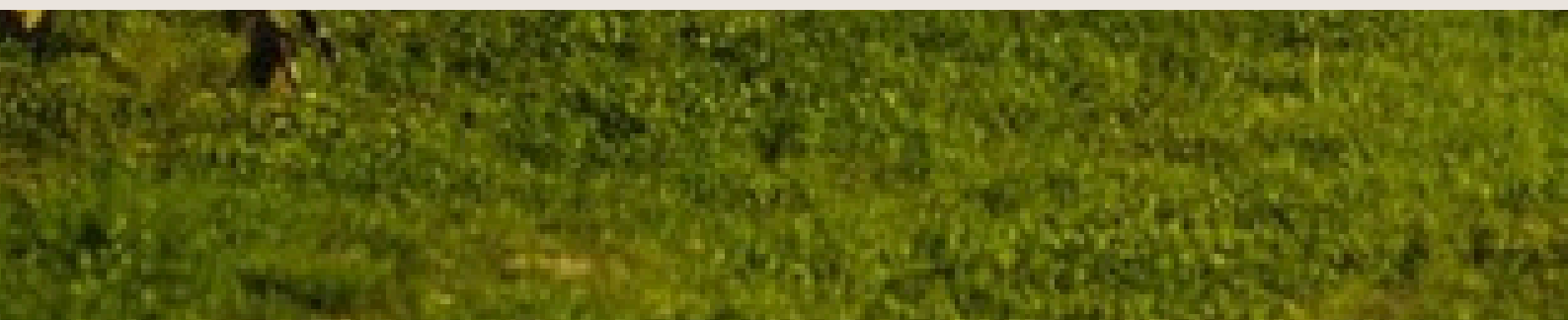

Taste and Tradition of Dubrovnik Countryside

Experience the Charm of the Konavle Valley

Join us for a half-day escape to the picturesque Konavle Valley, just 20 km south of Dubrovnik. Discover the region's rich traditions and warm hospitality as we visit three welcoming local hosts. We begin in the charming village of Čilipi, where a family estate introduces us to traditional olive oil making. Enjoy tastings of homemade Prošek and freshly pressed olive oil.

Next, we head to a scenic estate by the Ljuta River, where our second host shares stories of Konavle's heritage. A short nature walk brings us to a historic water mill, where we'll see flour milling and wool processing in action. We'll also enjoy local delicacies, including liqueurs, candied almonds, prosciutto, cheeses, and regional wines. Our final stop is a family winery for a tasting of local wine liqueurs and wines.

Included

- Tasting and snack at mlinica (mill) Đivanović (tasting - homemade liqueurs, candied almonds and orange peels, snack – prosciutto, cheese, olives and cucumbers, white and red wine)
- Tasting at Winery Brajković (wine liqueur, white and red wine) Tasting at Kameni mlin - family house (Prošek, Olive oil)

Island of Korčula with Wine Tasting

The fabulous architecture and rich history make the Old Town of Korčula a definite highlight of Croatia's sixth-largest island.

At first sight, the curvy alleys and stone walls, the glistening palaces and quirky churches might strike one as a replica of Dubrovnik, but it's the fine stone masons of Korčula who saved their best work for their hometown. After exploring the birthplace of the great traveler Marco Polo with a knowledgeable guide, enjoy time swimming, shopping or simply discovering the wavering alleys. On your drive back, toast to your lovely day with a glass of the region's signature red Plavac Mali at one of the wine cellars in the Pelješac peninsula.
