Trip starts with a hotel pickup, leading to your first glimpse of Dubrovnik from Mount Srd, where sweeping panoramas await. In the serene setting of a clifftop restaurant, you can unwind with your favorite drink while savoring the spectacular view. The tour continues to the picturesque Franjo Tudman's Bridge, with panoramic vistas of Gruz Bay, the Dubrovnik River area, Babin Kuk, and the western islands. You can choose to end your tour with a drop-off back at your hotel or at one of the Old Town's entrances – whichever suits your plans best.

WINE TOUR KONAVLE

Embark on a journey to discover the wines

This wine tour offers you the chance to visit up to three wineries, where you can delight in local flavors while listening to the engaging stories of passionate local winemakers. Among the diverse wine expressions, the traditional Malvasija Dubrovacka grape truly stands out.

This unique white variety was first documented in the Middle Ages, and you'll gain fascinating insights about it directly from those who nurture its legacy. Beyond wine tasting, this six hour experience allows you to enrich your day with a visit to one of Konavle's cultural landmarks, such as the picturesque town of Cavtat or the historic Sokol Grad fortress. You can also indulge in local gastronomy at one of the region's renowned restaurants, adding an authentic culinary touch to your adventure.

WINE TOUR PELJEŠAC

Visit Peljesac, one of Croatia's most renowned wine regions, and taste some of Croatia's best wines

Peljesac, the country's second largest peninsula, just a 50 minute drive west of Dubrovnik, is home to Plavac Mali, an indigenous red grape variety that produces some of Croatia's finest wines. Your eight-hour wine adventure begins with a scenic drive along the coast. Before indulging in wine tasting, you'll have time to explore Ston, a charming fortified medieval town at the very start of the peninsula. After free time in Ston, your journey continues through the Dalmatian landscapes on the way to the wineries. Traditional stone houses, olive groves, and vineyards unfold along the way – some set in small karst fields, others sprawled across gentle and steep slopes – offering a glimpse into the diversity of flavors awaiting you on this adventure.

EXPLORE DALMATIA (TRSTENO-STON-HODILJE)

Mali Ston oysters are renowned as some of the finest in the world

This six-hour tour takes you west of Dubrovnik. The first stop along the scenic Adriatic coast is Trsteno, where is historical arboretum. With its lush greenery, the arboretum is a oasis for nature lovers. It also boasts representative Dubrovnik summer residence architecture, which served as one of the most iconic backdrops in the popular Game of Thrones series. After a stroll through the arboretum, your journey continues with a 40-minute drive to the medieval town of Ston. Here, you'll discover some of Europe's longest defensive walls, which you can climb for spectacular views. Ston is also home to the ancient saltworks, where salt has been continuously harvested since the Middle Ages. The area is renowned for its oysters, which, along with other fresh seafood, have made this region one of Croatia's true gastronomic gems.

KONAVLE VALLEY

Relax and enjoy a scenic drive

Your exploration begins in Cavtat, where you can enjoy a peaceful seaside stroll and visit landmarks like the Rector's Palace, the Mausoleum, or the Bukovac House. Beyond Cavtat, Konavle's rural landscape offers a unique glimpse into traditional life. The best way to discover local heritage is to visit the Konavle Heritage Museum in Cilipi. After stopping in this quaint village, the tour continues to the Ljuta River area. Here, you can take a leisurely walk through lush surroundings, visit old watermills, and enjoy a meal at one of the riverside restaurants. Next, we'll take you to the Sokol Grad, a fortress tracing back to ancient times. For those interested in local crafts, the tour can be extended with a unique demonstration of silk production, showcasing Konavle's long-standing textile traditions.

MONTENEGRO (PERAST-KOTOR)

Discover stunning Adriatic coastline

While Montenegro's coastline may not be long, it features one of the most spectacular landscapes in the region. The Bay of Kotor, where this tour takes you, is home to scenery reminiscent of a fjord. Passing along the bay, you'll enjoy views of the steep mountains and coastal towns. Among them, Perast and Kotor – your destinations on this journey – stand out. Both are located in the innermost part of the bay, which is a UNESCO World Heritage site. In Perast, which sits right on the water's edge, you can take a relaxing walk, sip a drink as you admire the Venetian architecture and stunning bay views, or take a boat ride to the islet of Our Lady of the Rocks and visit its church and museum. Just a 25-minute drive from Perast, Kotor presents a distinctly different experience. Unlike the open waters of Perast, Kotor's beauty is safeguarded by its walls. A walk through Kotor's picturesque streets, lined with stone-paved paths and centuries-old buildings, brings new discoveries at every turn.

Discover Diocletian's Split, the second-largest city in Croatia, situated approximately 3 hours drive from Dubrovnik!

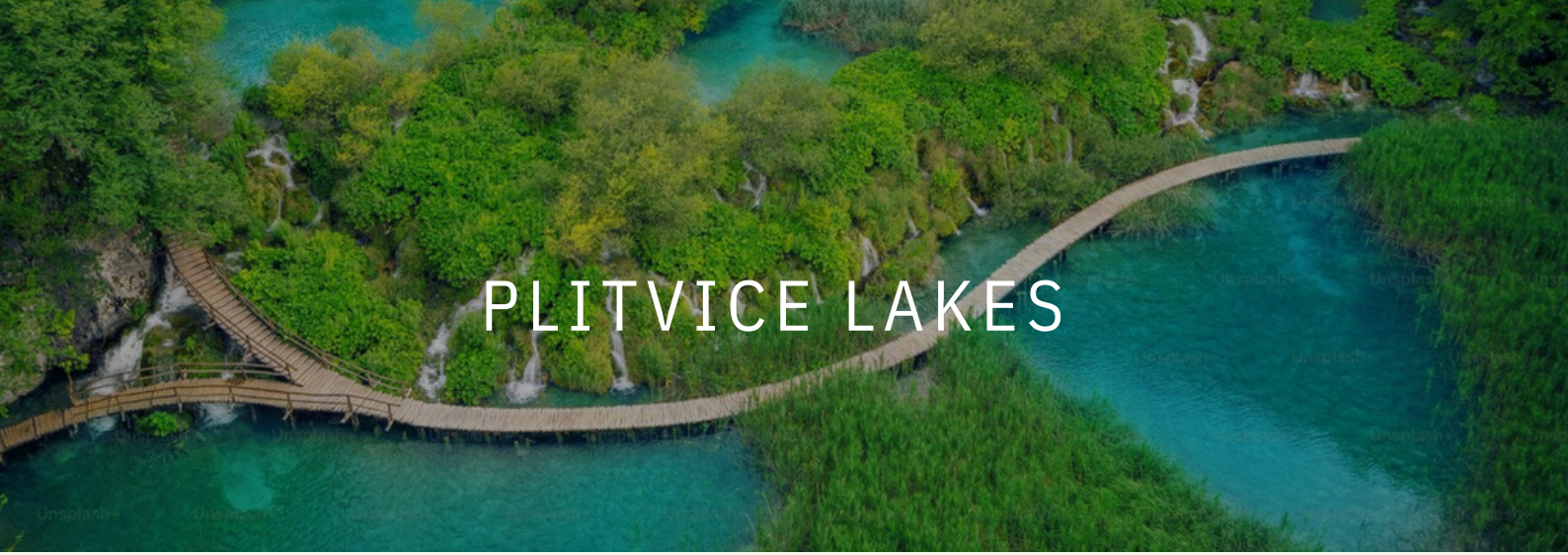

MEDJUGORJE

Since its first apparition in 1981, it has become a symbol of faith and spiritual reflection

Just a two-hour drive from Dubrovnik lies Medjugorje, one of Europe’s most renowned Marian pilgrimage sites, which offers a perfect opportunity for a meaningful day trip! Medjugorje is a town in southern Bosnia and Herzegovina. Its story changed forever in June 1981 when six local children reported seeing an apparition of the Virgin Mary in a nearby hamlet. From that moment, life in Medjugorje has never been the same. Despite efforts by the former Yugoslav regime to suppress the phenomenon, pilgrims continued to arrive, undeterred by the oppression. What makes Medjugorje unique is the ongoing nature of the apparitions – some among the original visionaries claim to still experience them today.
